The 19th Annual Cincy Blues Fest
(presented by Time Warner Cable) will be on
Friday, August 5, 5:00pm to midnight, and
Saturday, August 6, 4:00pm to midnight
at Sawyer Point Park (705 East Pete Rose Way).

The event features more than **30 Acts on 4 Stages:**

- Budweiser Main Stage: **Nationally Touring Blues Acts**, plus special performance by students from **Blues Society's *Blues in the Schools* Program**
- Friday Night Arches Theme Stage:
Rockabilly!
- All day Saturday at the Arches:
Boogie-Woogie Piano Hall of Fame Stage
- St. Vincent DePaul Local Stage: showcasing the **best of Cincinnati's blues scene**, including top performers from the Cincy Blues Challenge

Bring lawn chairs or blankets and enjoy the whole day at the park. **Enjoy great food and drink options**, including premium beer and wine, BBQ and Cajun cuisine.

Proceeds support the *Blues in the Schools* program, which strives to keep the blues alive, educate students about history and cultural significance of the blues.

Admission is \$15 each day (2-day passes will be sold for \$25 at the gate on Friday).
